2025 **GOALS**

Community Interactions:

- Continue seeking ways to interact with the Rescue Mission:
 - Weekly chaplaincy
 - o Regular in-depth Bible studies for Mission Academy students
 - Participate in presenting devotionals
 - Sponsor Academy graduates at bi-annual Retreats
 - o Seek to include residents in regular events
 - Hold social gatherings at the Rescue Mission
- Develop opportunities for members to serve each other. Specifically, start a Prayer Group with regular prayer chains for needs as they arise.
- In addition to Retreats, hold two additional social events

Communications:

- Create more interaction on YouTube via weekly Bible studies, Monday Love Notes, Interviews with Women at the Well
- Consistently post on Facebook and Instagram. In addition to links for weekly Bible studies and Monday Love Note, include inspirational and personal testimony posts

Retreats:

- Continue holding two Retreats per year, offering scholarships to those who cannot otherwise afford to attend.
- Evaluate other ways of providing a similar experience at a lower cost.

Weekly Bible Class:

- Continue with weekly YouTube Bible studies
- Begin exploring options to meet in person for Bible studies.

Finances:

- Increase regular, recurring donors by 20%
